GROW FRESH FOOD HERE, AND FEED OUR COMMUNITY!



East New York Farms! is acquiring this 4,500 square foot site at Hendrix Street and Livonia Avenue. Part of this space will be farmed by the UCC youth program, and we want to make part of the space available for a few other community members with a specific interest in growing for our market.

We are now seeking applications from committed growers interested in joining with us to develop and farm this new land!

We are looking for applicants who:

- Have a clear plan for what they would like to grow and sell at the market
- Have shown commitment to food production and selling at the East New York Farmers Market
- Need more growing space to scale up their production
- Represent a multi-generational group including youth interns, program alumni, and adult gardeners

Members will be expected to:

Commit to using sustainable growing methods to intensively produce crops for the market
Sell a minimum number of times at the East NY Farmers Market, relative to how much space they have

- Contribute time to overall garden tasks, including building beds and infrastructure, watering, weeding common areas, and other tasks necessary for the on-going maintenance of the site - (For adults) Be open to mentoring younger growers who are also members of this site

Members will receive:

- A <u>maximum</u> of 380 square feet of growing space (twelve 4 x 8ft raised beds); likely less in the first year

- Training and mentoring from UCC staff

- Assistance from our youth program (offered on a rotating basis to all gardeners)

- Access to shared supplies such as trellising, compost, etc

Questions and Answers about our new farm site

Q: What is the purpose of this site?

A: Our goal is to use this site to increase access to fresh food in East New York by making space available for community members who have a specific interest in growing for our market, and need more space in order to do so. We also want this farm to provide a unique opportunity for alumni from our youth program to grow and market their own crops, while working alongside and learning from more experienced growers. This site will further our mission to organize young people and adults in East New York to advance food justice.

Q: How do I qualify for a spot at the Farm?

A: To qualify for an application, an individual should:

- Be a resident of or a gardener in East New York, and be selling at the East NY Farmers Market or have a proven interest to sell at one of our markets.
- Have a developing plan of what you will be producing.
- Have a need for more space in order to scale up their production.

Q: How much space could I get?

A: Member will get a <u>maximum</u> of 380 square feet of growing space (twelve 4 x 8ft raised beds); likely less in the first year. Space will be allocated based on crop plans developed, need for space, prior farming experience, prior involvement with East New York Farms!, and number of applicants.

Q: How do I create a successful application?

A: Successful applicants have a well-thought out, practical plan for a project that will improve their agricultural business, and will know what materials and training they need to carry it out. They also demonstrate the character necessary to follow through on their project, a commitment to the East New York Farms! Project, and the community commitment to successfully grow for market. Applicants should feel free to discuss their ideas with East New York Farms! staff.

Q: When should I turn in my application?

A: Applications must be received at UCC (613 New Lots Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11207) by Tuesday May 1st, by 6:30pm. You can turn them in in-person, by mail, or by email to <u>david@eastnewyorkfarms.org</u>

Q: What will happen after I turn in my application?

A. ENYF will meet to review the application, contact you if we have any questions, and schedule a time to meet to discuss your crop plan.

Q: What support will I receive if my application is approved?

A: Gardeners will receive access to some basic shared supplies, one-on-one and group trainings in farming and marketing techniques and support to sell cooperatively at our farmer's markets.

Q: What are the requirements for members?

A: To maintain their spot at the garden, members must:

- Be an active member of the East New York Farms! Project, by, for example, being available for oneon-one assistance, participating in group workshops focused on advanced growing techniques, and attending monthly project meetings. Members would not have to attend every workshop and meeting, but make themselves available for at least some.
- Attend one annual meeting for the garden site.
- Participate in our Harvest Count, to measure your harvest.
- Harvest and sell your produce at a minimum number of farmers markets (Weds or Sat, at your own stand, a shared market stand with other members, or our share table) in a given year. The number required of each member will be relative to how many beds you have.
- Use sustainable growing techniques and use your space efficiently to grow for market.
- Contribute time to overall garden tasks, including building beds and infrastructure, watering, weeding common areas, and other tasks necessary for the on-going maintenance of the site
- (For adults) Be open to mentoring a younger grower who is also a member of this site.
